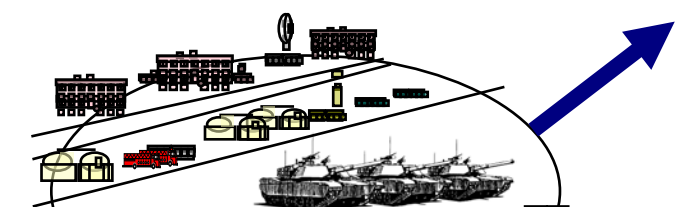

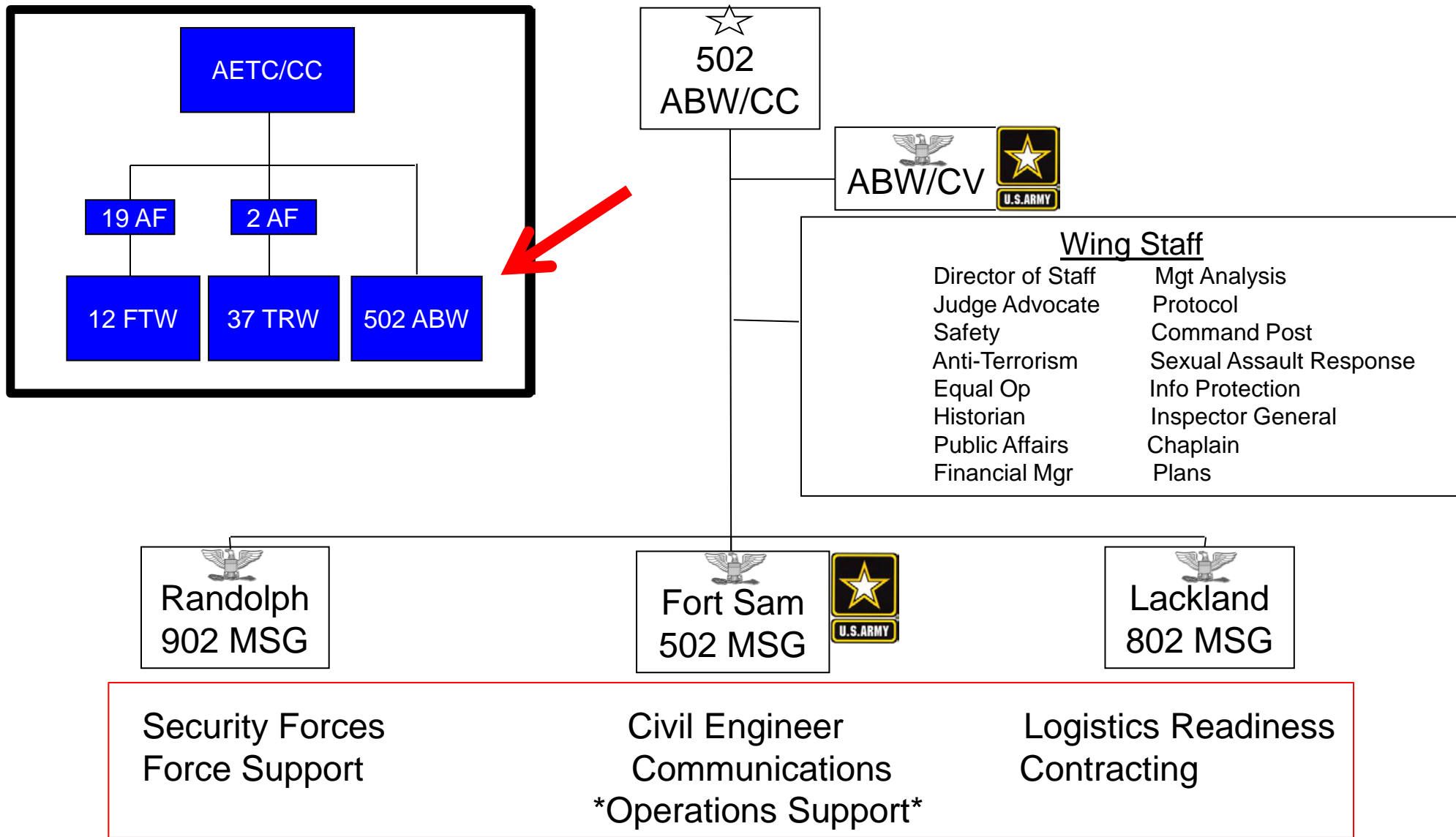

# SA Real Property Mgmt Agency (SARPMA)



## Background

- SARPMA Established 1977-1978, activated 1989
- Forced upon the AF by General Accounting Office (GAO) because they believed that centralized management was more efficient
- Mission: “to provide economical, efficient and effective Civil/Facilities Engineering support for the needs specified by the SARPMA Charter”
- Included Brooks, Lackland, Randolph AFB, Fort Sam Houston, Camp Bullis and Wiley, Segov Auxiliary, San Antonio AFS, 22 Army Res centers, and the Randolph and Fort Sam Houston facilities at Canyon Lake.

## Lessons Learned

- Be responsive to customers – SARPMA caused damage to its reputation in early years
- Set expectations – SARPMA did not meet predicted savings, which was the sole reason for creating the org in the beginning
- Perception matters – Installation Commanders believed that SARPMA did not respond adequately to their needs
- Continue to evolve with time – Need an atmosphere of flexibility & enthusiasm

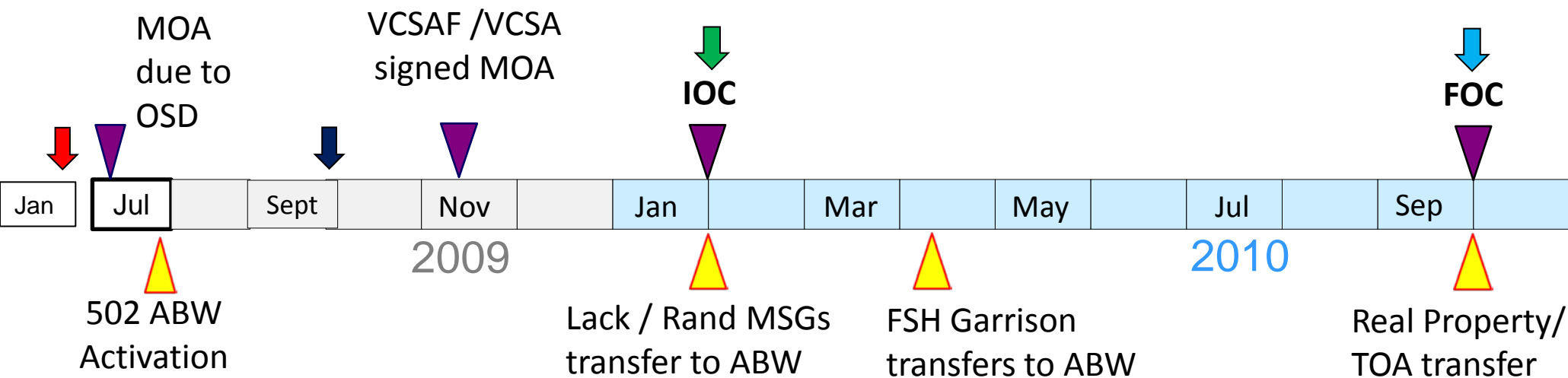

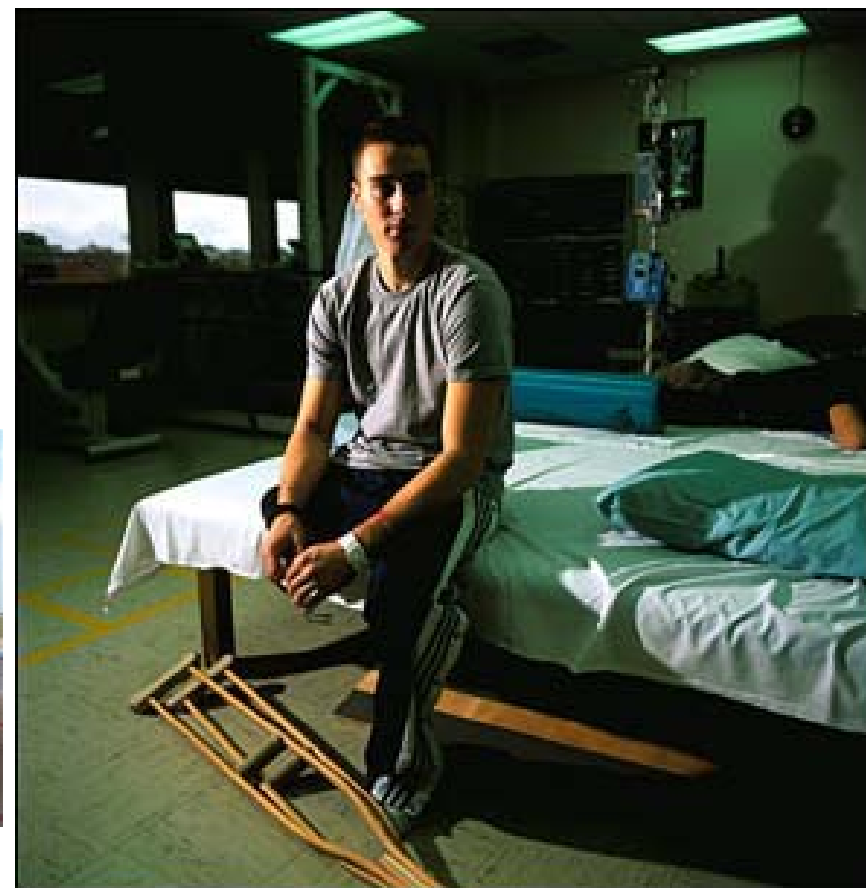
